

Prof. Tatjana Josifova is an ophthalmologist who has received her education at the University Eye Clinic in Skopje, as well as at the University Eye Clinic in Würzburg and Nurnberg/ Germany.

Working Experience:

Prof Josifova's main focus is on retinal diseases and vitreoretinal surgery. She worked as a Head of retinal vascular disease at the University Eye Hospital in Skopje, Macedonia. At the University Hospital Basel, Switzerland Prof. Josifova formed the Medical Retina Department, and acted as the Head of the same department. Together with her Co-workers she took a part in different international studies, concentrating mostly on the problem of Age Related Macula Degeneration. At the University Eye Clinic in Basel, Prof Josifova also had the clinical position of the Head of the Operating Theatre, Ambulance as well as Head of the In-Patient Department. She was also a member of the team for Retinal Emergency Surgery at the University Eye Clinic in Basel.

Current Clinical Position:

Prof. Josifova currently is working as retina specialist and vitreoretinal surgeon at the Eye Clinic "Prof. Fankhauser" in Bern as well as at the Eye Clinic Orasis in Reinach, which is a part of the Swiss Eye Foundation Group, where she has the position of a Deputy Chef.

Academic Activities:

Prof Josifova has published chapters in books, as well as papers on retinal diseases. She has been presenting her clinical studies on international congresses and at seminars for young ophthalmologist. She has also taken part as a moderator and speaker in different workshops in vitreoretinal and trauma surgery.
